The tournament begins Saturday July 20, 2024, and will conclude on or before Saturday, July 27, 2024 to declare a state champion. The games will begin Saturday, as listed on the enclosed double elimination tournament bracket. Managers and coaches will be required to be at a 9am meeting, Saturday, July 20 to review all roster affidavit books/packets and to meet with tournament staff and review tournament operations and procedures..

We will be announcing each team, players, managers, and coaches and district represented before each of the teams' first game. During your teams' announcement, you may display your District Championship Banner and Home League Banner if you have one. Please forward me your rosters as soon as possible so that we may review them for pronunciation - a form is attached. Please complete as much of the information as possible.

At our facility, the state tournament will be completed on two fields – one with a grass infield, and one with a dirt infield. We will be utilizing temporary mounds set at the Little League Majors pitching distance and are 10" high, which is within the Little League Guidelines.

Little League rules do not permit the wearing of metal spikes or cleats (Rule 1.00-h) Please inform your players of this rule. Should you have any questions please feel free to contact me and I will be happy to assist with whatever I can.

On behalf of our tournament committee, Ohio District 9 Little League, and the Hamilton community, we look forward to being your host for this memorable tournament experience.



2024 Little League Majors Division Baseball State Tournament Welcome Packet

The following information is provided to assist with your tournament experience:

Dates: July 20- 27, 2023

Eligibility: District Champions from the Ohio Little League Districts will be participating in the tournament.

Format: Double Elimination Bracket. IF GAME will be utilized if needed.

Game Times: See Attached Bracket and Schedule

Equipment: Participating teams will be required to provide their own Little League approved equipment. All bats must be Little League approved by the USA Baseball bat standard. Catcher's masks must have "dangle" style throat guard. Baseballs will be provided by the host site.

Awards: 2024 Ohio State Champion will receive a State Championship Banner and individual award. Each player will receive a Little League State Tournament Participation Pin.

ASAP Plan: West Side Little League has an approved Safety and Awareness Plan for the 2024 season. The ASAP plan is available in the concession building.

Rosters: Player Eligibility – Each team shall provide the completed Affidavit Packet of all eligible players and coaches.

Affidavit Packet: Each team's manager must check in with the Tournament Director prior to their first tournament game with the affidavit paperwork. This affidavit must be signed by your league president and district administrator. Each team must further have a medical release form for each player in their possession. This is a Little League state tournament, and we will follow all rules per Tournament Section in the 2024 Little League Rulebook.

Game Times: Each team will be allowed 10 minutes to take infield. This will commence 30 minutes prior to game time. Pre-game practice schedule TBA. We pride ourselves in providing the players a top- notch field for the games and appreciate your patience as our field crews prep and reset ball fields before and between games.

Home/Visitor: Home/Visitor will be determined by a coin flip. The team traveling the furthest may call the flip. Winner of the coin flip may choose home/visitor and loser of the coin flip may choose dugout. Please report to scorer's table 40 minutes prior to game time for coin flip. This will provide sufficient time for each team to enter their dugout prior to pregame infield.







Weather Delays: Prompt communication between all managers and Tournament Director will be required to minimize unnecessary travel in the event of weather delays. We will communicate via text, email and Ohio Little League District 9 Facebook page to update weather delays.

Sportsmanship: Little League promotes good sportsmanship. All Little League rules and West Side Little League Park rules will be strictly enforced. Throughout the tournament, any conduct that is meant to demean or incite opposing teams, spectators or officials will not be tolerated. We encourage comments to be positive and supportive of your team.

Audio announcement and music: Only the host site may make in-game audio announcements or play music during the game. Teams are not permitted to play individual walkup introductions, walkup music or music between innings.

Webcasting (Streaming Video on the Internet): Little League International has the exclusive right to authorize any and all webcasting (live or recorded) of tournament games. As a non-commercial webcast, or with sponsorship limited to those products or services which meet Little League International standards for advertisements (see below and Attachment A), Little League International grants you the rights to record for webcasting and/or to webcast live, the above-mentioned sports event (EXCLUDING REGIONALS). Whether or not the Little League name and/or marks are used to solicit advertising revenues, the rights fee is established at \$175 per game for each game to be webcast. The webcast in perpetuity is the property of Little League Baseball and Softball. Each game posted to a website in its entirety also comes with a fee, please see page four (4) for complete details. (Note: One hundred percent of this fee will accrue to the local Tournament Committee to offset expenses.) This grant of webcasting rights pertains only to the sports event at the time and place specified herein. This contract is non-exclusive. The exact fees noted above will be determined by District Administrator and Tournament Director in consultation with the Little League International Director of Constituent Communications. Radio Broadcast/ Audio Streaming: Little League International has the exclusive right to authorize all radio broadcasting/ audio streaming (live or recorded) of tournament games. As a non-commercial broadcast/ audio stream, or with sponsorship limited to those products or services which meet Little League International standards for advertisements, Little League International will grant you the rights to broadcast via terrestrial radio or audio stream, the Ohio State Little League Majors Tournament. Whether or not the Little League name and/or marks are used to solicit advertising revenues, the rights fee is established at \$100 per game, as determined by the Little League International Communications Department for Little League Media Contract fees. The broadcast/ audio stream in perpetuity is the property of Little League Baseball and Softball. This fee will accrue to the local Tournament Committee to offset expenses. This grant of radio broadcasting/ audio streaming rights pertains only to the sports event at the time and place specified herein. This contract is non-exclusive. NO TOLERANCE POLICY: Violators will be removed from the field for the duration of the Tournament. Any players or coaches ejected or removed from the field will not be allowed to participate in their teams' next game per Little League rules. Tournament staff and umpires will strictly enforce all rules.

All Safety Rules will be strictly enforced.







General Points of Emphasis:

- 1. All bats must follow Little League Guidelines. USA Baseball Bats only. NO USSSA 1.15 bpf bats permitted.
- 2. **MINIMUM 12 MAN ROSTER:** Each team must have a roster of 12 players as signed off by their respective District Administrator.
- 3. MANDATORY PLAY CONTINUOUS BATTING ORDERROSTER BATTING: Mandatory Play is now Continuous Batting Order. The entire roster muster be submitted for lineup. All defensive substitutions shall be reported to the official scorekeeper. A courtesy runner may be used for the pitcher or catcher with 2 outs. The last player who batted out will be used as the courtesy runner.
- 4. No extra personnel other than roster players and coaches are permitted on the bench or in the dugout.
- 5. Players are not allowed to leave dugout or field of play while game is in progress.
- 6. Players must have Little League patch on their uniform sleeve.
- 7. Coaches may not warm-up pitchers at any time.
- 8. Catchers must always wear a catcher's mask with a dangling throat protector (pregame practice, pregame infield, warming up between innings.



General Information / Helpful Hints

- 1. There will be a **MANDATORY** Team Manager Meeting on **July 20, 2024** at **9:00 AM** at **West Side Little League Park**. At this meeting the tournament format, schedule, and rules will be discussed. All questions about the tournament will be answered at the meeting. Please feel free to ask any questions you might have.
- 2. The following will be reviewed at the above meeting or before your first game:
 - Team Affidavits and supporting paperwork.
 - Medical Release Forms
- 3. Games will be played in accordance with Little League Tournament Rules
- 4. Umpires will check all equipment prior to each game faulty equipment will be removed and will not be allowed to be used.
- 5. Pitching Affidavits will be filled out completely following each game. The Manager is responsible to ensure the affidavits are accurate.
- 6. Teams should arrive at least one (1) hour prior to the scheduled game start time.
- 7. Warm up areas will be provided. No hitting balls against the fences.
- 8. TTeams must pick up trash in dugout before vacating PLEASE LEAVE IT BETTER THAN YOU FOUND IT
- 9. **NO COOLERS** are allowed inside the park (with the exception that the team may have a cooler in the dugout with drinks, wet towels, etc).

10. The use of any tobacco products, vapes and alcohol is **strictly prohibited** inside West Side Little League Park. Smoking is allowed only in the designated areas **outside of the complex – No Exceptions**.

NO TOLERANCE POLICY: Obscene language or harassment by anyone will not be tolerated. Offenders will be immediately ejected from the park and the tournament
